Introduction

What You Get

The WP Voting Wiz plugin for WordPress is extremely simple to use, and enables you to quickly and easily add drop-dead-simple visitor feedback to all of your posts, pages, and comments. It does this by adding a simple thumbs up and thumbs down icon in the relevant places on your blog or website.

When someone clicks on one icon or the other, it registers the vote, notes the IP address and looks to see if it can't match up the IP address with a previous subscriber, editor, or admin to your blog or website who's left a comment or post before, so you know who it is where possible.

This gives you and other visitors to your blog or website a fast idea regarding whether the particular content is well liked or not.

In Addition

The plugin only allows one vote per IP address unless the visitor is logged in to the site. This then allows multiple people at the same location to individually vote on the content.

As an example of a killer usage of this plugin, it would be ideal for use on a membership site where the members are paying for content. You would see right away which content is popular and well liked and which you should steer away from.

Installing

Simply upload the plugin zip using the WP admin panel browser uploader and activate.

Alternatively

1. Unzip and save the extracted folder somewhere you can find it.
2. Use your FTP client (like FileZilla) to upload the folder to your /wp-content/plugins/ directory on your WordPress blog or website.
3. Login to your WordPress admin page and activate.

Upgrading

1. First BACK UP YOUR WORDPRESS DATABASE! We won't take any responsibility for your data, you have to look after it yourself.
2. Deactivate the existing version of the plugin.
3. Use your FTP client to delete the existing plugin.
4. Unzip the new version and save the extracted folder somewhere you can find it.
5. Use your FTP client to upload the newly extracted folder to your /wp-content/plugins/ directory on your WordPress blog or website OR use the new plugin uploader to install the upgrade.
6. Reactivate the plugin.

Trouble Shooting

If your blog or website displays with a "headers already sent" error message when you activate the plugin or otherwise adversely affects your blog or website, then the first thing you should do is delete the plugin with your FTP client, and your blog or website will be restored to normal.

Usage

Menus

Once the plugin is installed and activated, you'll see a new menu in the admin sidebar.



Clicking on the first link to "WP Voting Wiz" will take you to a settings page where you can optionally check two boxes.

Manual Updates to a Theme

Checking either box will cause new textarea boxes to appear underneath.

Checking these boxes will reveal the code for you to manually add to your theme if it doesn't support the code additions automatically.

Copy and paste the code into your post and comment templates supplied with the theme you're using.

This should only be used when your theme doesn't automatically support the required hooks to display the up vote and down vote icons. Most recent themes will already have this support built in so you shouldn't need to do anything, but if you're using an older theme then you may have to modify the theme code.

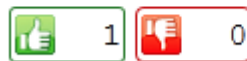
What You See

Your visitors can now start voting on content they read. This voting is enabled on comments, and also on post and pages too so you can see if people like what they're reading.

Viewing Your Statistics

In the admin panel, you can see statistics for the content that people have voted on individually for posts, pages and comments.

Two yellow callout boxes provide additional information:

You'll see how many up and down votes, and also the most recent IP address of the person who voted last. You'll also see a link to the detailed statistics for the content.

On the details page you'll see a list of up and down votes with the IP address of each person that voted. Those people who are logged in or leave a comment (requiring name and email address) will be identified within the admin panel so you'll have an idea of who regularly leaves positive feedback and who doesn't.
