## Installing

#1 - Unzip and save the extracted folder somewhere you can find it.

#2 - Use your FTP client (FileZilla?) to upload the folder to your /wp-content/plugins/ directory on your WordPress blog.

#3 - Login to your WordPress admin page and activate.

## Upgrading

#1 - First BACK UP YOUR WORDPRESS DATABASE! We won't take any responsibility for your data, you have to look after it yourself.

#2 - Deactivate the existing version of the plugin.

#3 - Use your FTP client to delete the existing plugin.

#4 - Unzip the new version and save the extracted folder somewhere you can find it.

#5 - Use your FTP client to upload the newly extracted folder to your /wp-content/plugins/ directory on your WordPress blog.

#6 - Reactivate the plugin.

## Backlink Renegade Plugin

The Backlink Renegade Plugin for WordPress enables you to create backlinks to your backlinks so that Google counts them and improves your target sites Page Rank (PR).

The reason this works so well is because if there's one thing that WordPress is VERY good at, it's getting itself indexed. And one of those reasons are the fact that when you make a new post, WordPress sends details of it to pingomatic which then gets redistributed to similar services. So Google will then see those new URLs and come visiting regularly.

The backlink indexer plugin takes advantage of those regular visits. It works by checking Google to see if a list of URLs where you know your articles are distributed have been indexed.

If a URL hasn't been indexed, then it displays the URL in the queue on your blog(s) until it IS indexed. If it has been, it's removed and replaced by another one and continues in this way until all your URLs are indexed, and so all your backlinks count.

I would suggest you would only want to use this plugin on disposable blogs, something on a cheap .info domain, just in case all the links rotating on a page trigger a spam flag with Google. If your cheap disposable blog gets de-indexed, then who cares? Just register another one and keep going.

You would get the original list of URLs to be indexed as the results of an article marketing campaign, or from a paid backlink exercise from a site like Fiverr.com.

## Usage

The first thing you should do is go to the " Backlink Renegade >>Settings" page in your admin panel.

Set the delay between URL indexing checks to something realistic like 360 minutes to 1440 minutes (6-24 hours). This will give Google time to spider your site and index your new URLs.

## Adding URLs

The next thing you'll need to do is add one or a list of URLs that you want to be indexed.

Go to the "Backlink Renegade >>Add URL" page, and either paste your single URL into the URL field, or if you have multiple URLs, check the box and paste your list of URLs into the box, one per line.

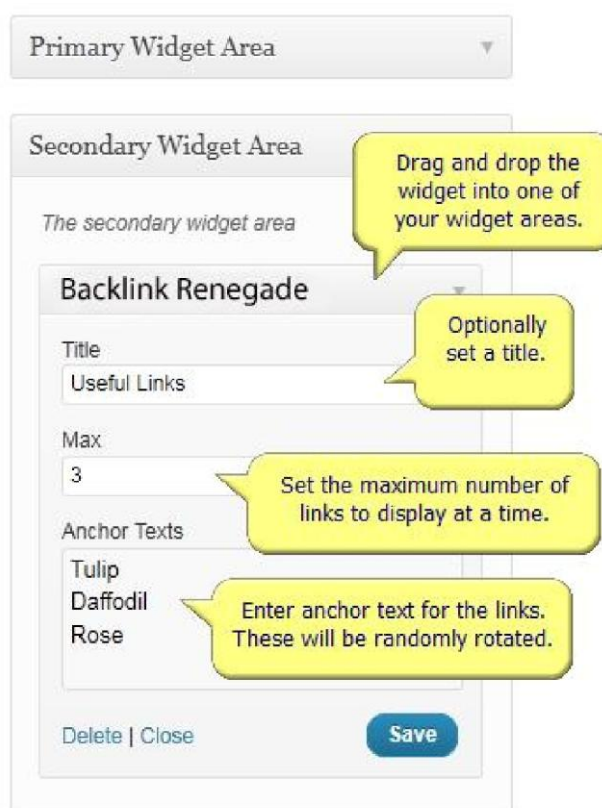
## Displaying URLs On Your Blog

Once you've added your list of URLs to the admin panel, the next thing to do is to display these URLs on the front of your blog.

Go to "Appearance>>Widgets" and you'll see there's a new widget.



Drag and drop the new widget into one of your widgetised areas and fill in the fields.



You can set the maximum number of links to be displayed at a time, and also the anchor text for the URLs.

If you now go check the front of your blog, you'll something like this in your sidebar or wherever you placed the widget.:-

On the front of your blog, these will be displayed until indexed, then replaced by the next unindexed URLs in the list.

The links with random anchor text will display on the front of your blog. As each URL gets indexed by Google, it will be replaced by the next URL in the list you pasted, and a random anchor text from your list will be applied to it.






Eventually all your links will get indexed.

## Viewing and Checking URLs

Now that the URLs are being displayed on the front of your blog, you'll want to check to see if the links are indexed. Go to "Backlink Renegade >>View All".

If the backlinks are still being checked for indexing, you'll see a rotating graphic to show the status is unknown.

Backlinks are being checked.

Once the status of the URL is known, this field will display either a red X to show that it hasn't yet been indexed, or a green check mark to show that it has.

When the status changes to green, you can safely delete the URL as you know that Google has now indexed it and has found the backlink to your other site.
